### The Heart Is Deceitful

All man-made religion is focused on the desires of men. Even when it wears the name “Christian”. When observing the world of Christendom, it becomes abundantly clear that worship is not God focused but man focused. Many justify their actions by saying that they “feel” like God will accept their worship because they are sincere. The only way for us to know that God accepts what we do is if we only do what He has commanded or expressed He desires. And if we love Him, why would we do something that He has not told us He wants? (John 14:15) Too many rely upon their feelings and their desires to guide them in religion.

In Jeremiah 17:9 God said, “The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?” Relying upon our feelings is a sure-fire way to fail. When we do so we have exchanged the desires of God for our own. We do things that we think are right but ultimately are detestable before God. For example, man once thought it was good and right to sacrifice children (Jeremiah 32:35). No one could reasonably argue in favor of child sacrifice. Yet, those involved in it were sure it was the proper thing to do.

Time and time again, the religious of this world turn to their own hearts for authority. In fact, at times when a denomination is going to be established, they will send out surveys to the community. Everything is catered to the communities’ desires, from music style to the types of messages, and programs. That is not God-centered religion. Paul, by divine inspiration calls this will worship, or self-made religion (Colossians 2:23).

Seeing that the heart is deceitful above all things we should turn to the one who can never lie (Titus 1:2). We should turn to the one we are to worship (John 4:23-24). We should turn to our head (Matthew 28:18) to determine how we are to live, worship, and work (Colossians 3:17).

Acts 26:25-29

- 25 But he said, "I am not mad, most noble Festus, but speak the words of truth and reason.
- 26 For the king, before whom I also speak freely, knows these things; for I am convinced that none of these things escapes his attention, since this thing was not done in a corner.
- 27 King Agrippa, do you believe the prophets? I know that you do believe."
- 28 Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You almost persuade me to become a Christian."
- 29 And Paul said, "I would to God that not only you, but also all who hear me today, might become both almost and altogether such as I am, except for these chains."
