Cities That You Did Not Build

The book of Deuteronomy is typically described as a retelling of the Law. The word Deuteronomy means “second law.” While there is obviously overlap between Deuteronomy, Exodus, Leviticus, and Numbers, we should never overlook any inspired book. There are still many wonderful lessons and admonitions we can apply to our lives today.

One such example is found in Deuteronomy 6. Notice verses 10-12, “And when the LORD your God brings you into the land that he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give you—with great and good cities that you did not build, 11 and houses full of all good things that you did not fill, and cisterns that you did not dig, and vineyards and olive trees that you did not plant—and when you eat and are full, 12 then take care lest you forget the LORD, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.” (ESV)

The land of Canaan is one that was often described as flowing with milk and honey. This is figurative language, of course, to describe the wealth and prosperity of the land. God would give this land to the Jews. They had no need to develop it. No need to till or plow it. No need to sow or plant. No need to dig for water. The land was totally prepared for the people. They just needed to take it.

What can we take from this? When reading this passage, I was reminded of the fact that the land of Canaan is often used as a type of heaven (Hebrews 3:7-4:13). Which leads us to the words of Christ in John 14:2-3 “In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.” Haven is a place that has been prepared for the people of God. The only thing we need to do is “take” it. This is not by military might but by humble submission to God.

One day we will inhabit that wonderful city that we could never build.
