Elias Roque is the Hispanic Minister at the West End Church of Christ (Iglesia de Cristo). Originally born in Honduras, Elias is a third-generation preacher who graduated from the Biblical School of the Americas EBA in the country of Panama with his bachelor's degree in Bible from Bear Valley institute (This school is overseen by Latin American Missions LAM from Valdosta, GA).

He has been preaching for over 26 years. He has helped establish congregations of the Lord's church in several locations including Honduras, Nashville, Great Oaks Iglesia de Cristo in Memphis, and in 2018 he moved to the St. Louis area to establish the only current Spanish speaking Church of Christ in the surrounding metropolitan area. West End Iglesia de Cristo started with just Elias, his wife, and children, and has now grown to having averaging 60 people in attendance on Sundays. Elias has a passion for preaching the gospel of Christ, and leading mission trips to Honduras in order to encourage local preachers and congregations with evangelism, Biblical educational classes, and benevolence to their communities. He has been participating in mission work since he was 13 years old in the countries of Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Panama, Chile, and the USA.

Elias and Kristi have been married for 16 years, and they have four sons. Eli (15), Noah (13), Isaac (10), and Abel (8). Kristi graduated from Freed-Hardeman University with a teaching degree and is currently homeschooling their four children. She also works as a translator for the local school district. The Roque family is always on the go, but in their free time they enjoy spending time as a family playing soccer, baseball, cooking, and being outside in nature.
