 - C. Corporal punishment is not the only discipline Pr. 29:15; Pr. 6:23.

 - A. To remove foolishness Pr. 22:15.
 - B. To impart wisdom Pr. 29:15.
 - 1. Thus giving the tools to guard the soul Pr. 22:5-6.
 - C. To teach discretion and prudence Pr. 15:5.
 - D. To deliver from the realm of the dead Pr. 23:13-14.
 - E. To bring joy and peace to yourself Pr. 29:17.
- III. When discipline is neglected.
 - A. The child will be bound up in foolishness Pr. 22:15.
 - B. The child will be brought to destruction 19:18.
 - C. The child will bring shame, grief & bitterness Pr. 29:15; Pr. 17:21, 25.
