- I. He offers peace between men.
 - A. Sin causes strife, turmoil, warring between men —

Jas. 4:1-2.

- 1. This is all due to sin 1 Jn. 2:15-17.
- B. Christ is the Prince of Peace.
 - 1. He says we are to love our enemy Matt. 5:43-48.
 - a. Many say, "I cannot do that."
 - (1) You will die in your sin 1 Jn. 3:14-15.
 - 2. Enemies can be brought together in Christ Eph. 2:14-19; Gal. 3:28.
 - 3. Let us live peaceably with all men Rom. 12:18.
- II. He offers peace to man.
 - A. Sin also causes enmity with God Jas. 4:4.
 - 1. Sin separates from God Isa. 59:1-2.
 - B. God is a just God Deut. 32:4.
 - 1. Sin will be punished Heb. 10:30-31.
 - C. Yet, He is our Savior Col.1:19-20.
 - D. Through Christ, man has peace with God Rom. 5:1.
 - 1. We have the privilege of prayer Heb. 4:16.
 - 2. We have a special relationship with God —

Rom. 8:16; 1 Pet. 2:9.

- III. He offers peace within man.
 - A. Sin also causes strife, turmoil and warring within man 1 Pet. 2:11; Rom. 7:22-23.
 - B. The Prince of Peace offers rest and tranquility to man—Rom. 7:24-25a; Rom. 8:1.
 - 1. Nothing can separate us from God Rom. 8:37-38.
 - C. As Paul wrote Phil. 4:6-7.
